Open Mic Guidelines

Do you like to make people laugh? Have you ever thought, “I sure do need an outlet for all this killer wit”? Are you a talented poet or riveting storyteller? How about a skillful musician? Or maybe you just need to tell the world about that absolutely crazy thing that happened at work the other day?

Here’s what you need to know to sign up for our Open Mic!

Open Mics will be held on the first Thursday of every month @ 8pm in King Auditorium.

We aim to have 6-8 performers for each open mic!

General Guidelines

We don’t want to limit your comedic genius, but here are some things to keep in mind:

- We aim to create a welcoming environment for everyone at the Park Theatre. **Please do not make any hurtful or insensitive jokes or comments at the expense of others.**
- Please exercise restraint when using profanity, lewd content, and graphic descriptions.
- Acts should be 5-10 minutes in length.
- We will provide a microphone and stand. Any additional equipment you need must be hand-held and brought up on stage when it is your turn.

The Park Theatre reserves the right to prohibit you from participating in future open mics if we deem your performance inappropriate or in poor taste.

How To Sign Up

- A fee of \$5 is required to reserve a spot in the lineup
- The deadline to sign up is a week before the open mic - contact programming@theparktheatre.org with the subject line “Open Mic” to get your name on the list!
- If you would like us to review or provide feedback on your set or the topics you will discuss, send us your script, outline, or video of your performance no later than 3 days before the open mic. This can also be sent to programming@theparktheatre.org
- The \$5 fee will be collected at the box office on the night of the open mic.
- Performers should arrive no later than 7:30pm on the night of the event!
